Development, Operation and Maintenance of a Multi Specialty Hospital on Public Private Partnership Mode in Ranchi, Jharkhand, India

Department of Health, Medical Education and Family Welfare (“**Authority**”) now invites interested bidders and/or bidding consortium and/or any consortium member thereof (“**Bidders**”) to purchase the Bidding Documents to participate in the bidding process for the selection of a private player through global competitive bidding process for implementation of the Project.
